

## **OCTOBER 2024 COMMITTEE REPORT**

- Mason Fire Department responded to a total of 8 incidents for September 2024 with a 100% response rate:
  - 4 EMS Calls
  - 2 EMS Calls (Tipton County)
  - 1 Grass Fire (Tipton County)
  - 1 Special Event
- 2. Wall repairs are still required to the front of the fire station. Exterior bricks are starting to crack without the support column.
- 3. Truck 73 is still out of service for a power related issue.
- 4. All SCBA items from the Assistance to Firefighters Grant have been received and inventoried. Payment has been requested from FEMA for their grant share of \$124,800.00. The department requires the purchase of eighteen mask bags in order to put units into service.
- 5. 2024 Annual hose, ladder, and hard suction testing were completed on October 8<sup>th</sup>. Eight sections of 1.75" attack hose and three sections of 3" supply hose failed. Four of those sections are under warranty. All ladders and hard suction passed testing.
- 6. Quotes are still being received for the replacement of the fire station's air conditioning/heating unit.
- 7. The department still requires the establishment of a vendor to purchase of EMS supplies.
- 8. The department would like to congratulate Firefighter William Treadway for successfully becoming certified as an Emergency Medical Responder (EMR).
